RESEARCH SUBJECT AND INTERESTS

My research interests and activity are related to avifauna and especially bird migration, wildlife interaction with human activities and natural environment management. Specifically, I attempt to contribute to the conservation of rare or endangered avifauna species and ecosystems through research and action for their protection, taking into account human activities.

My research activity can broadly be divided into three categories:

- a) Avifauna in wetland ecosystems
- b) Birdlife in forest or mountain ecosystems and
- c) Impact of birdlife on human activities.

The research in the first category concerns:

- the biology (reproduction, diet) and ecology of specific species or groups of birds belonging to the families of herons (Ardeidae, Threskiornithidae), waterfowl (Anatidae, Phalacrocoracidae) and wading birds (Scolopacidae),
- the investigation of their populations and the change in their numbers over time during migratory or winter periods,
- their distribution and habitat use in the ecosystems they inhabit.

This type of research, which was implemented at a national level (with emphasis on wetlands of Macedonia and Thrace), contributed to further knowledge of the status of these species in our country, and was utilized in studies for the delineation of protected areas and the drafting of special management plans and national action plans. So far, I have participated in at least 15 programs with a relevant subject. The most important of these were:

- a) two programs regarding the study of migration phenology and investigation of the impact of hunting on waterfowl, which were implemented in the period 2004-2008,
- b) an international program related to bird flu and
- c) an international program related to the protection of the most endangered water bird in Europe, the Lesser White-fronted Goose (2011-2017).

The research in the second category mainly concerns bird species that inhabit forest and mountain ecosystems. I had the opportunity to investigate this issue within the framework of a LIFE project of the Greek Biotope Wetland Centre (EKBY) in forest areas in 1996, which included research on species and their populations as well as the preparation of specific management plans. In addition, through my participation in an ETHIAGE project that was ongoing in 2001 when I joined the Forest Research Institute as a researcher. Through this investigation, in addition to the registration of species and populations, I was given the opportunity to "experiment" with management practices that were implemented within

the framework of this project with the aim of conserving certain globally threatened species. Furthermore, I tried to identify and record the impact of human activities on the bird fauna of forest and mountain ecosystems and to present for the first time in Greece a "guide" on what should be taken into account in forest management so that it does not negatively affect bird species.

Since 1999, I have been investigating the impact of fish-eating birds on fisheries, a topic that constitutes the third category of my research interests. The main impetus for this investigation was the complaints of fishermen about the damage caused by some bird species to their "fisheries" that I often heard during my research in wetlands. The first opportunity to start this investigation arose in a working meeting with an expert from England. Then, since 2000, I participated in a pan-European project on the reduction of competition between fishermen and fish-eating birds. With the participation of many researchers from many countries in this project and through the working meetings, I had the opportunity to gain expertise on this topic. In addition, I "took advantage" to further investigate this topic more thoroughly in Kerkini lake through an international project. My research continued until the end of 2008 with my participation in a European project that included collaboration between researchers from many European countries and working meetings with a specific topic each time regarding the problem of the impact of the Cormorants on fisheries and ways to address it in each country. The research on this topic continued, and in the period 2014 - 2015, I participated in a project on cormorants and fisheries in the National Park of Eastern Macedonia and Thrace.

Finally, since 2023 I have been participating in a program assigned to our Organization by FRAPORT Greece that concerns the diet of the Kestrel. This bird species is associated with accidents due to their collision with airplanes. The ultimate goal of the program is the reduction of such accidents at "Macedonia" Airport in Thessaloniki.

Occasionally I also dealt with other categories of wildlife species, e.g. research on a part of the benthic fauna of the Aegean Sea (Echinoderms).

In an effort to contribute to the management of the natural environment from another "battle position", the administrative one, during the period 2017-2022 I participated in the administration of the Kerkini Lake Management Body (as President of the Board in the period 2020-2022)

Job description: Drafting specifications for the scientific - research part of the program, finding the working group, monitoring the implementation of the research, drafting reports and writing the National Action Plans for the two species.

Results: The project was successfully completed, and the results are included in the papers numbered H3, H4 and D2 as well as in the popular articles Ia2 and Ib1. The National Action Plans for the Pygmy Cormorant and the Lesser White Fronted Goose were the first plans for avian species in Greece. Due to the international interest of the project and its results, the National Action Plans were published both in Greek and in English.

The operation of the raptors' feeder on Mount Jena continued after the conclusion of the program by local bodies that participated in the implementation of the program's management actions in the area.

Job Description: Collecting information and data on how fishermen and the state in Greece are dealing with Cormorant-Fisheries Conflicts. I actively participated in the project's work in Brussels, Lisbon, Bautzen, Germany and the Po River Delta in Italy. At the last working meeting, I presented the results of the investigation in Greece. Information about the project can be found on the website www.intercafeproject.net

Results: The program completed at the end of 2008 and the final reports were included in work O10. For the first time in Greece, the problem faced by fishermen in the lagoons (especially in Thrace and western Greece) was highlighted with specific data and the State and the competent services were informed about it.

innate immune response of birds - INN FLU»

The institutions participating in the program from Greece were the Department of Veterinary Medicine of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, the National Agricultural Research Foundation – Forest Research Institute (FRI) and the Evros Delta Management Body.

Purpose of the program: The purpose of the "work package" in which Greece participates is to investigate the existence of the virus in wild birds, its resistance to water and various types of sediments (wetland bottoms) as well as the monitoring of the migration of birds that are vulnerable to the virus (aquatic). The purpose of the research undertaken by FRI was to monitor the existence of the virus in certain bird species with emphasis on Whooper Swans and to investigate the origin of aquatic birds wintering in Greece.

Position: Member of the research team. I participated in all phases of drafting the proposal and research plan in Greece in collaboration with the Greek and Belgian partners of the project.

Job Description: Collection of samples from specific bird species (Mute Swans, Coots and Black-headed Gulls) for analysis for avian influenza. The samples were taken from the oropharynx and the larynx, while blood samples were taken from the Mute Swans. Mute Swans and Black-headed Gulls were ringed with metal and colored plastic rings or collars, while systematic monitoring of the changew in the number of swans in Lake Kastoria was also carried out.

Purpose of the program: Safeguarding of the Finno-Scandian population of the Lesser White-fronted Goose along its migratory route from Finland and Norway (its breeding areas) to Greece (its wintering area). In Greece, particular emphasis is given to Lake Kerkini and the Evros Delta with conservation and research actions, study of the species' ecology (diet), research on the impact of hunting, management of feeding areas as well as informing hunters about the importance of the species. FRI undertook four actions: A) Investigation of the impact of hunting on the Lesser White-fronted Goose B) Analysis of the Lesser White-fronted Goose's diet, C) Preparation of a management plan and restoration plan for feeding and roosting habitats in the Evros Delta and D) Management of feeding habitats. The research found that the flooded rice fields in the wider area of the Axios delta during spring and summer constitute a very important feeding habitat for the herons that nest in the delta.

The results filled a very important research gap for the avifauna in Greece.

The longest-lived rediscovery of a bird I ringed was a White Egret ringed at the Axios Delta in 1989 and was found in Niger after 17 years, while Mute Swans ringed in Siberia were found in southern China and Greece (see related articles).
